Sewing Classes

Elementary Level

Sewing Machine Basics

Class # 2.1

This introductory session is for adults with little or no sewing experience. Learn about sewing tools, terminology, and basic functions of your sewing machine. Bring your machine along with its accessories and instruction manual.

One 2-hour session: \$35.00

Exploratory Sergery

Class # 12.1

Need help with operating your serger? In this class, you will practice threading your machine, learn basic serging techniques, and find how to adjust tension settings for various stitches and fabrics. Bring your serger, accessories and instruction manual.

One 2-hour session: \$35.00

Beginning Sewing

Class # 20.1

This adult class is for new sewers or those needing to refresh their skills. You will make a pair of elastic waist pants or skirt using a pattern provided in class. Must know how to use a sewing machine.

Three 2-hour sessions, includes pattern: \$95.00

Intermediate/Advanced Level

Personalized Fitting and Sewing

Class # 10

We offer assistance with garment sewing, including pattern alterations and sewing techniques. These private instruction sessions are for those who have at least moderate skills in clothing construction. Make an appointment with Janet to discuss your project.

Fee: \$20.00 to \$30.00 per hour depending on topic.

Important Information

- Knitting classes are taught by Dick Dapson; sewing and crochet classes are taught by Janet Dapson.
- *You must speak directly to the class instructor to register and schedule your class.* Due to high demand, plan to schedule a class at least 2 weeks in advance of your desired time frame.
- *Deposit or full payment for any class must be made at the time of registration or received within five business days of registering for the class.* Class will automatically be cancelled if payment is not received in the allotted time.
- *Refunds will not be given for missed classes.*
- Cancellation policy for registrants requires 24 hours notice. Because of preparation time and expenses incurred, 80% of the registration fee is refundable.
- Should a class be cancelled by Fabrications, money will be completely refunded.
- There may be homework with some of the classes. To get the most out of these classes, you must be able to complete the assigned homework.
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis.
- A class supply list, where applicable, will be issued upon receiving paid registration.
- For best results, we strongly recommend that yarn or fabric be purchased at Fabrications. Students receive a 10% discount on class supplies. If you wish to use your own yarn or fabric, it must be approved by the instructor before class day.

Knitting and Crochet Classes

All classes are by appointment only, maximum 2 people. Class fees are \$20 per hour plus any applicable supplies.

Elementary Level

Basic Crochet

Class # 15.1

Learn the basic crochet stitches as well as their abbreviations used in patterns. Or get assistance with a current crochet project. Variable kit fee for needed supplies.

Basic Knitting

Class # 61.1

Learn the four basics of knitting: casting on, the knit stitch, the purl stitch, and binding off. Approximate time: 2 hours

Simple Knitting Project

Class # 61.2

Learn to follow a pattern for either a Simple Elegant Scarf (ribbing and cables) or an Easy Hat (ribbing, decreases and knitting in the round on circular needles). Approximate time: two 2-hour sessions plus homework. Variable kit fee for yarn and needles.

Special Knitting Projects

Class # 62.1

Need help with a pattern? Want to tackle something more advanced like customizing a sweater pattern, designing a sweater from scratch or making socks to exactly fit your feet? The amount of class time will depend on the project and your skill level; much of the work will be done by yourself. Obtain supplies and make a gauging swatch before the first class.
